Tote bag pattern

Lined tote with fabric handles.

The pattern below is for the small tote. If you wish to make a larger tote alternative measurements are at the end of the pattern.

To make one small tote you will need:

- One 4 x 42 in strip of fabric for the handles
- Two 13 ½ x 14 in pieces for the outer bag
- Two 13 ½ x 14 in pieces for the lining

To stitch the handles:

- Press fabric strip in half lengthwise. Open fabric up and press each outside edge to the centre.
- 2. Fold fabric in half and press. Top-stitch down each side of strap close to the edge. Cut fabric in half so you have two straps about 21 in long.

To stitch the tote:

- 3. The bottom of the bag is 13 1/2 in wide and the sides 14 in long. Lay lining pieces right sides together and stitch down each 14in side and across the bottom. Leave a 3in opening on one 14in side.
- 4. Stitch the two outer fabric pieces right sides together on three sides, leaving the 13 ½ in top open.
- 5. To "box" the bottom of the outer bag. Pinch bottom corner together, lining up side seam with bottom seam and stitch across 1 1/2 in from the corner. Trim off excess fabric. Repeat for other corner and also lining corners.
- 6. Turn outer bag right side out and position handles 3in from each outer edge. Stitch to outer bag with a 1/8 in seam.
- 7. Place outer bag inside lining so that the right side of the fabric is facing. Stitch around the top edge.
- 8. Turn bag through opening in the side seam and stitch the opening closed.

9. Press well and top stitch around the top edge of the bag.

Measurements for a larger tote:

- One 4 x 42 in strip of fabric for the handles
- Two 15 x 18 in pieces for the outer bag
- Two 15 x 18 in pieces for the lining

For the larger tote you will need to position the handles further in from the outer edge.

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
