How does your Garden Grow?

Stitch a naïve garden landscape using blanket stitch appliqué on a felt background. Embellish with buttons, 3D flowers and big stitches. Your stitched picture can then be made up as a small wall hanging or book cover or cushion.

Materials needed:

- Cream felt 9" x 11".
- Small pieces of felt in a variety of colours.
- Small pieces of fabric for the 3D flowers.
- Embroidery thread.
- Buttons.
- Sewing equipment such as needles, pins, scissors and cotton thread.

Instructions:

- 1. Cut out all paper pattern pieces. Use the paper pattern pieces as templates to cut out the shapes from felt or fabric.
- 2. Using the embroidery thread, blanket stitch the pole and the birdhouse to the centre of the cream felt rectangle. Using a running stitch add the hole on the birdhouse.
- 3. Blanket stitch the wheel barrow to one side of the birdhouse and add the wheel using a running stitch.
- 4. To make the suffolk puff flowers: Use the circle template to cut out the desired number of circles from cotton fabric. On each circle take a running stitch around the edge turning under 1/4". Gather and back stitch to secure. Stitch these into the wheelbarrow.
- 5. To make the folded flowers: Use the circle template to cut out the desired number of circles from cotton fabric. Mark the centre of each circle with a cross. Fold over one edge of the circle to the centre mark and press in place. Working in a clockwise direction, fold over the next edge of the circle to the centre and press. Repeat four more times. Secure the centre with a few stitches. Stitch these randomly under the birdhouse in the garden.
- 6. Using the remaining flower templates cut a selection of flowers from felt. Stitch these into the garden either using blanket stitch or running stitch. Add a bird and/or bees to the sky.
- 7. Stitch in grass and leaves using green embroidery thread.
- 8. Stitch buttons to the flower centres and any garden novelty buttons to the picture as desired.
- 9. To finish your picture you could now stitch it to a piece of fabric and complete the project as desired.
